- Group Discussions: The European perspective of Ukraine

## Schedule of the Summer School (planned)

- Arrival on 2 July 2026; departure on 11 July 2026 (travel days)
- Lectures (from 3 to 10 July 2026, except Sunday) from 8.15 to 13.15; afternoons are free (there are plenty of leisure activities possible in Wiesbaden and the Rheingau region)
- Excursion to Frankfurt/Main
- Get-together and group dinner

At the end of the Summer School, all participants will receive a **certificate of attendance**. Those who sit an oral examination at the end of the Summer School will receive a **graded certificate** (worth 3 ECTS)

## Organisational matters

The **participation fee** for the Summer School is € 20, payable on arrival.

Participants are responsible for arranging their own **travel** and **accommodation**; the university is available to assist. A financial grant may be awarded upon application (particularly for students from Ukraine)
