The Summer School provides different approaches qualitative research methods for Social Work. There will be an introduction to Ethnography, Narrative Approaches and the use of Photos as Instrument and Object of Research in the field of Narrative Practice and Community Work, Action Research and Social Group Work. These research methods stand also for participative Social Work Methods in groups, communities and interpersonal interaction. The investigations are based on an appreciate and collaborative inquiry of the persons account. These methods are also embedded in emancipative action research which aims to improve the social condition with the participants and not do it for them. People will be seen as subjects and not as research objects. During the two weeks of the Summer School there will be take place an German Language Course and a cultural program in which the wonderful landscape around Wiesbaden will be explored.

The spirit of the Summer School in Wiesbaden 2011 can be described by the critical and creative tradition of Paulo Freire who pointed out: People – subject to scientific research – shall be given a voice by a communicative, dialogue-oriented and participatory scientific approach. Or else they will be drowned by the otherwise mainstream abstractive discourses.



Students Workload in total for International Students: 120 hours
Students Workload in total for German Students: 180 hours (with exam)

The special characteristic from summer school is that there will be given credits which are being accepted from the sending university.

Our participating students get 3 credits for Modul 8 Nr. 1830 and Modul 10 Nr. 2040 and all participating students get a certificate.

The charge fee for students is € 150.-
