#### What is the time schedule at WBS?



	Summer Semester	Winter Semester
Semester dates	1 April - 30 September	1 October - 31 March
Lecture period	April - July	October - January
Semester break	Easter (4 days)	Christmas (1 week)
Examination period	July/August	January/February




### What if the semester times overlap?

How and when do I apply for an exchange to WBS?



As part of the exchange program, you may apply to us after successful nomination by your home university.

Application link will be sent to you by mail.

If you are not sure whether the WBS is a partner of your home university, please contact the International Office of your university.

**freemovers** can be accepted if there are enough free places.

#### **VISA**

Do I need a visa or residence permit?

You can find a current **overview of visa requirements** on the website of the <u>Federal Foreign Office</u>.

Within two weeks after your arrival you must declare your place of residence at the local City Hall.

#### Health Insurance

Can I use a travel insurance?

No, <u>travel insurances are **not**</u> <u>accepted!</u>

**EU-Citizens** submit the European Health Insurance Card (EHIC), issued by your health insurance company.

All other nationalities

are strongly recommended to arrange sufficient health insurance in Germany (approx. EUR 90/month).

#### Accomodation

How do I apply for housing?

We will be happy to help you **find suitable accommodation** for your stay
with us.

We hold (currently a small!) room
contingent with two private
accommodation providers in
Wiesbaden. Application form for housing
will be provided with your application
link.




When will I be notified of my acceptance?

Invitation letters for visa purposes and acceptance letters can be expected approximately two weeks after the application deadline.

Do I have to pay tuition to study at WBS?

No, but prior to online enrolment Incomings have to pay a semester fee (ca. 260 EUR/semester, compulsory) which includes a liability insurance and the study ticket for free use of regional public transportation in most parts of Hesse and some places in Rhineland-Palatinate.

### START PACKING YOUR BAG



What do I need for **enrolment**?

Detailed information will be provided to you in time, but in short, it's just your passport/ID card plus photo, proof of health insurance, admission form and payment of semester fee.

Are there any **scholarships for Incomings**?

For European exchange students: You might apply for ERASMUS+ funding. Our ERASMUS Code is **D WIESBAD01**. Please contact the coordinator at your home university to do the

We currently do not offer any general scholarships for incoming students from oversea partner universities, but we encourage you to contact the <a href="Mailto:German Academic Exchange Service">German Academic Exchange Service</a> (DAAD) where you will find further information on scholarship possibilities.

Do we speak one language?



Do I have to speak German to come to WBS on exchange?

No! However, for language of instruction, we recommend level B2 (German or English) to follow the courses.

For beginners and intermediate learners we provide a **free German Intensive course** (4 ECTS) two weeks prior to semester start.

During the semester exchange students benefit from more than **75 additional course offerings by the Language Center**.

In which language can I study at the WBS?

We offer **German and English taught Business courses**. The wide range of courses taught in English is even being expanded!
A list of business courses taught entirely in English will be provided to you.



#### Course Choice



What can I study?

You are free to choose any course from all WBS bachelor programs on any level in accordance with the requirements of your home university (e.g. Learning Agreement) or personal interests, courses taught in German or completely in English.

Please talk to your coordinator at your home university first regarding recognition!


The exact schedule for the **lecture guide** for the new semester will be published 4 weeks before the start of the semester...

## Course Registration





How can I register for courses?

In a detailed information session, you will receive a comprehensive course offer and description as well as instructions on how and when to enroll for courses.

Shortly before your arrival you will receive your user ID "HDS" (HochschulDirectoryService). This **HDS password gives you central access** to all student IT systems, including course (StudIP) and exam registration (Compass).

#### **Exams and Certificate**





How do I register for the exams?

You register for the exams via **Compass**.

In order to ensure that everything runs smoothly and that you register correctly, you give your course choice to the International Office beforehand.

We will remind you of deadlines and help you!

How do I get my results and when do I get my transcript of records?

You can check your results anywhere anytime in **Compass**.

The official transcript of records will be **issued about 4** weeks after the end of the examination period and sent to you and your home university.

If you need to **re-sit an exam**, please contact us to find a solution!
