Please always use the Course ID when communicating. Only the course ID clearly describes the course with its five-digit number, the course name is often ambiguous. The first number stands for the study program, the second for the degree, the third for the semester.

For example, course ID **71412** = **7** (International Management), **1** (Bachelor), **4** (4th semester)
